TEACHING:

I taught total laparoscopic hysterectomy and infrarenal lymphadenectomy techniques at four international meetings of the Society for Gynecologic Oncologists, I have been active in the education of student and other physicians since 1986. Currently I give Grand Rounds in many hospitals and universities internationally, teaching about laparoscopic hysterectomy and lymphadenectomy techniques, and about the biological origins of sexual orientation and gender identity. In 2006, I founded LIGO, the Laparoscopic Institute for Gynecologic Oncology, and produced fourteen successful courses jointly sponsored by ACOG on Total Laparoscopic Hysterectomy and Advanced Pelvic Support Procedures annually from June 2006, to present, training over 2,000 gynecologists. I directed and have taught at the laparoscopy lab for the Society for Gynecologic Oncology at the international annual meeting in March, 2014.
